NORTHWEST MISSOURI STATE UNIVERSITY ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP



Northwest Missouri State University has been offering students a dynamic learning environment for over 100 years. This award will represent the value of the difference in price between in-state and out-of-state tuition. It is equivalent to approximately \$5,700 during your first year based on 28 credit hours (the scholarship total will vary based on credit hours taken). The scholarship is renewable the second year if a student completes 24 unique credit hours (superseded credit hours do not count twice) with a 3.0 GPA. If a student does not maintain continuous enrollment they will lose their waiver. All students entering on NIAS funds will receive an extensive session on how to maintain funding for their entire degree.
